RCOC TO BEGIN HEAVY MAINTENANCE WORK ON ORCHARD LAKE THIS WEEK

Beverly Hills, Mich. — The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) expects to begin work Tuesday, June 30, weather permitting, on heavy maintenance work on Orchard Lake Road between 14 Mile and Maple roads in West Bloomfield Township.

During the work, the three center lanes will be closed for approximately one-quarter of a mile, beginning at Maple Road and heading south. Throughout the work, one outside lane will remain open in each direction, and access to all businesses and side streets will be maintained at all times.

The purpose of the work is to prepare the three center lanes for the anticipated resurfacing of the road which is expected to occur later this year.

The work is expected to take three to four weeks to complete, depending on how many days it rains. The work will be performed by RCOC crews.
