

### First 100 Days:

- Approved an ordinance amendment to suspend water shutoff for hardship cases
- In a bond rating call, the Supervisor and Treasurer improved the bond rating from a AA- to a AA+, which resulted in strong positive results in a bond sale for Parks and Recreation
- A financial forecast was conducted through 2012, revealing a \$14 million shortfall in revenue
- The financial forecast has assisted with union contract negotiations and future planning
- The two-year expired contract with the Firefighters union has been ratified, outside of costly arbitration
- Contract talks continue with the other six unions working under expired contracts
- The Board consolidated the Building Department and Code Enforcement for an annual savings of approximately \$100,000
- A Four-Year Financial Plan is being prepared for Board approval in May 2009
- The Board approved a resolution to become a participant in a \$250,000 Capital Cooperative Investment Revolving Fund (CCIRF) feasibility study to evaluate a collaborative agreement with six other municipalities to establish a new revenue stream for the township and, ultimately, eliminate the need for landfills
- The Board approved a resolution for the Orchard Lake Corridor to participate in cost sharing for an overlay on Orchard Lake Rd. between 14 Mile and Maple and for the design of a 4-lane boulevard
- A Stimulus project list of \$42 million was submitted to the Governor
- Stimulus priority projects have been submitted to local legislators
- The Supervisor has scheduled weekly Process Improvement meetings with the Building Department to establish performance metrics and streamline processes
- The Board approved funds, and a demo has been conducted, for a software module in the Building Department that will take service to a new level
- The Board established a Personnel Committee, comprised of Trustee and Chair Larry Brown, Trustee Steve Kaplan and Trustee Howard Rosenberg
- The Board established a Road Committee, comprised of Chair Norah O'Brian, Supervisor Michele Economou Ureste, Clerk Catherine Shaughnessy, Trustee Larry Brown, Resident Lorna McEwen and Resident Richard Barr
- The Road Committee has conducted over 100 hours of fact finding and holding strategic partnership discussions with the Road Commission of Oakland County (RCOC) and Farmington Hills regarding the Orchard Lake Corridor
- The Board approved the Planning Commission nominations of Trustee and Board Liaison Steve Kaplan and Jim Manna
- The Board approved the Cable Board members of Harvey Gersin and Deborah Macon
- The Board approved the Zoning Board of Appeals member Robert Sher
- The Clerk established an electronic "list serve" to assist with enhancing communication to residents about Board meeting agenda items
- The Treasurer expanded the list of bank depositories to minimize risk of investments
- The Board approved a Citizen Advisory Council as an Ad Hoc Committee
